Notes of wild berries, dark spice, subtle espresso and plum precede a crunchy, comparatively full-bodied palate for St-Romain, framed by chalky tannins and juicy, ripe acids. This bottling boasts extra depth and richness this year, but like its white sibling it retains lovely freshness too.
